## **New England Society for Coatings Technology** **Scholarship Program**

The scholarship program of the NESCT was founded with the principal objective to promote the further academic and intellectual development of individuals.

The following are our guidelines and requirements for the dispersal of the scholarships:

1. At least one member of the immediate family must be a member in good standing or be employed by a company that has a current member of the NESCT.
2. An official application and supporting documents must be submitted on or before June 30, 2010.
3. Scholarship candidates must be pursuing post high school studies.
4. Applicants meeting the above qualifications are eligible for consideration. The NESCT wants to convey the idea that the promotion of education and technical excellence in the coatings industry is the top priority for the dispersal of scholarship awards. Therefore, scholarships will be awarded in the order of priority as listed below:
  - A. Children of members or children of employees whose company has an active member in the NESCT. The applicant must intend to pursue studies in a field related to the coatings industry.
  - B. Any person currently employed in the coatings industry who is a member of the NESCT and intends to pursue studies in a field related to the coatings industry.
  - C. Secondary considerations will be given to the above categories of people who pursue a field of study not related to the coatings industry.
5. All applicants will be notified by mail of the committee's decision, whether they are selected or not.
6. The amount of the scholarships will be determined each year by the Committee.
7. All decisions made by the Scholarship Committee for the selection of the awards are final.

### **Instructions for Applicants**

The following specific items are to be submitted:

1. Official application form completed in the applicant's own handwriting.
2. Transcripts of applicant's college and/or high school showing grades for the enrollment to date for all schools attended.
3. Copy of official document showing SAT scores, if available.
4. A short essay about an aspect of coating technology and its benefit in your daily life.

*All items should be mailed in one package.*

*Deadline is June 30, 2010. No entries will be accepted after this date.*
